Cranford Hospice is once again giving Hawke's Bay people the chance to remember loved ones with their annual Trees of Remembrance appeal.

During December they will have Christmas trees located at various spots around Hawke's Bay. Hospice and community volunteers staff the collection tables and trees.

At the tree a lovely Christmas star decoration is offered for people to write on, in memory of someone special or someone who is unable to be with them at this time. People are welcome to hang the star on the Cranford Hospice Tree of Remembrance or take it home and put it on their own tree.

A donation to Cranford Hospice is appreciated. Cranford Hospice Events & Special Projects Manager, Emma Buttle, claims that this appeal would not be possible without the volunteers who make it happen, *"we are extremely grateful to all businesses and individuals who contribute to this important Cranford Hospice fundraiser – we are always overwhelmed with how supportive the local community is with this annual initiative. This is a major fundraiser for Cranford Hospice, and is a vital contribution towards the \$2 million it needs to raise every year to provide free specialised care to people with a terminal illness, as well as their families and whanau.
